Entry Criteria:

Limit one entry per student. Each entry must:

- Artwork is limited to the size 12-inch x 18-inch poster board or paper size
- A video presentation of the art and/or a digital art submission is acceptable
- No photography or trademarked/copyrighted characters may be used on any entry
- Picture of the front and back of artwork to your school site's office email on or before December 4,

Judging Criteria

Winning entries will be selected based on creativity, originality, fulfillment of contest guidelines, and expression of the virtual contest theme "What can we do?" This theme was based off our virtual learning environment and how we may support one another specifically with cyberbullying.

• Each school site will judge all entries based on the above criteria. Principals will send pictures of their top three finalists in each grade level to Student Services by Monday, December 7th.

District winners will be announced and displayed virtually on our district and school websites by mid-December.
